#### **GUIDING PRINCIPLES**

- Increase overall instructional time
- Increase access to interventions for all students
- Is supported by cognitive neuroscience, cognitive load theory, and best practice
- Improve the pace of the day
- Provide longer instructional periods
- Contain opportunities for collaboration
- Provide flexibility for adjustments to meet students' needs



### SCHEDULE FRAMEWORK

- Homeroom is 10 minutes
- Each block is 57 minutes
- Schedule runs on a 5 day framework. The schedule will run Monday-Friday with 3 days of one period dropped and 2 days of two periods dropped
- Days of the week are locked (e.g. Monday schedule always the same)
- Snow days will not change the schedule outside of extreme circumstances



## SCHEDULE REVISION BENEFITS

Framework Overview	Revision Benefits
Homeroom is 10 minutes	Maintains a check-in point for all students
Each block is 57 minutes	Maintains longer instructional blocks
Schedule runs on a 5 day (Mon - Fri) framework 3 days drop one period, 2 days drop two periods	Increase frequency of class meetings
Days of the week are locked (e.g. Monday schedule always the same)	Consistent and predictable
Reallocated student FLEX time	Maintains benefits of current FLEX time while maximizing student support and extension opportunities
Snow days will not change the schedule outside of extreme circumstances	Uses the regular FPS school-year calendar and does not require a "rotation" calendar
